VIP-tour and official opening ceremony



The flagship exhibition and conference event of the country's fuel and energy sector, **the 28th International Oil & Gas Exhibition and Conference – OGU**, which has been held since **1997**, became the foundation for the development of the entire **Uzbekistan Energy Week (UEW) platform** and served as a catalyst for the growth of related industry events.

OGU 2026 was held on a large scale **from 12 to 14 May 2026** at the **CAEx Uzbekistan International Exhibition Centre**.

The traditional VIP Tour, marking the official opening of the exhibition, was led by the Minister of Energy of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Jurabek Mirzamakhmudov, and attended by the Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Jamshid Khodjaev; the Minister of Energy of the Republic of Belarus, Denis Moroz; the Deputy Minister of Energy of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Orkhan Zeynalov; the Vice Minister of Energy of the Republic of Kazakhstan; the Secretary General of the Gas Exporting Countries Forum (GECF), Mohamed Hamel; the Acting Secretary General of the Energy Charter Secretariat, Atsuko Hirose, and many other distinguished guests. The Plenary Session became the key event of the official opening of Uzbekistan Energy Week.

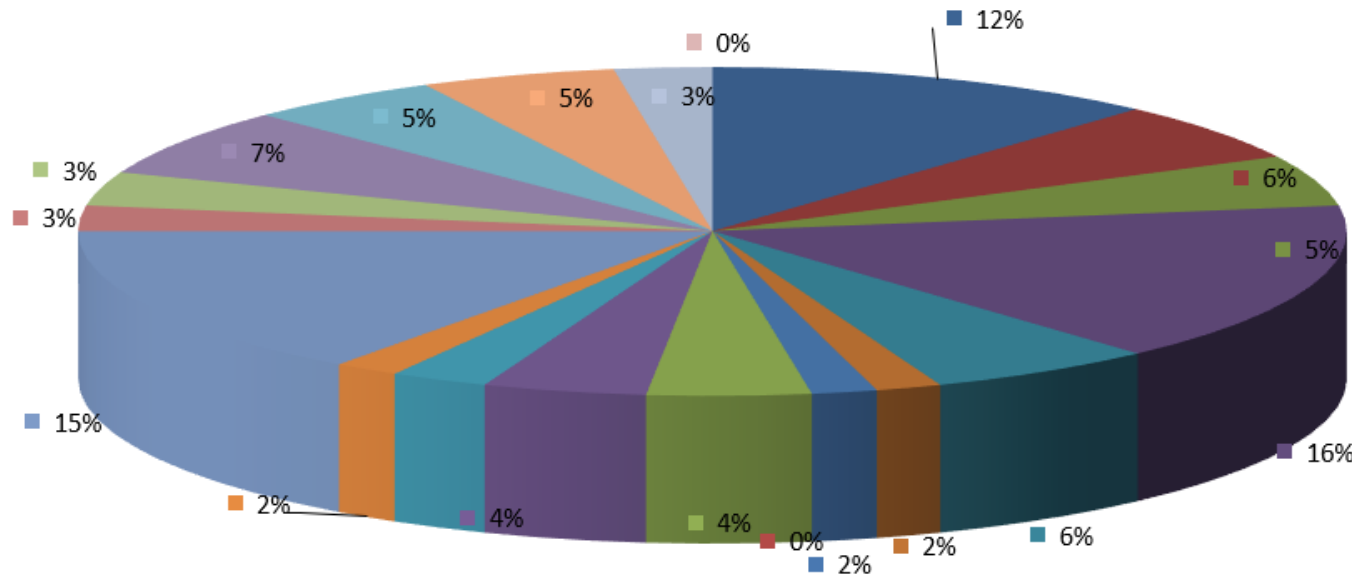

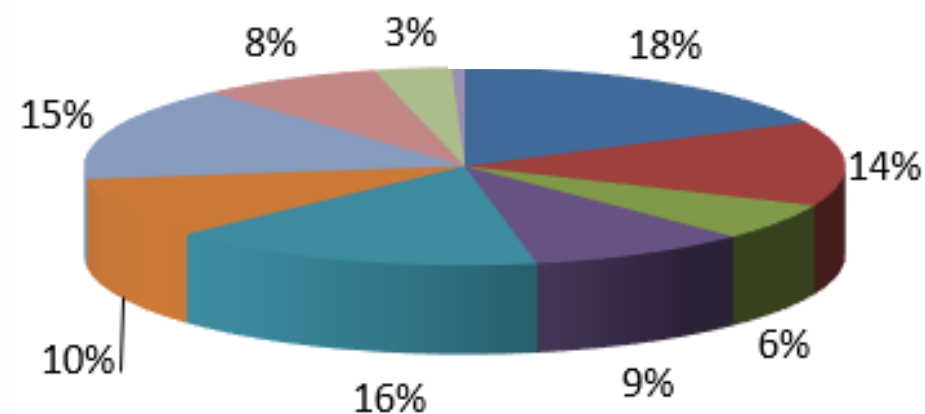

The Forum featured an extensive programme comprising **16 sessions** dedicated to the most pressing issues of industry development and regional cooperation in the energy sector.

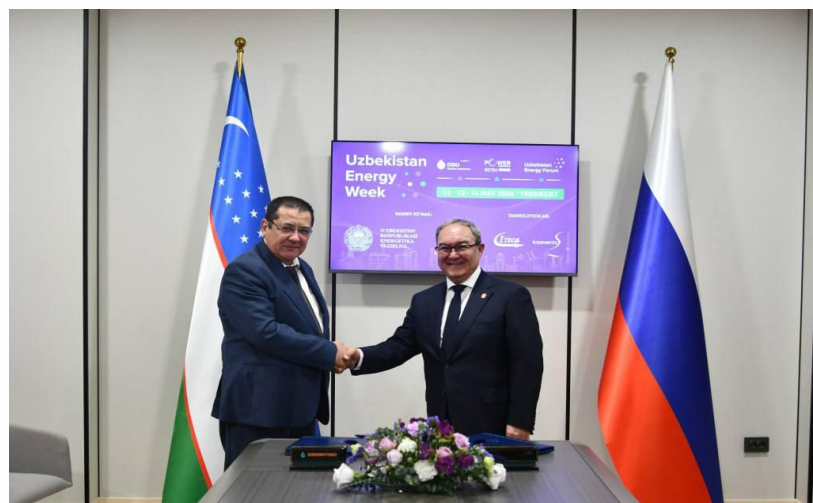
